Mactan Cebu International Airport welcomed the arrival of Philippine Airlines' new Bombardier Q400 Next Generation aircraft last August 1.

PAL Express President Mr. Bonifacio Sam and Bombardier Director for Asia Pacific Sales Mr. Aman Kochher, among other VIP guests and media, graced the sendoff ceremony of the aircraft's 1st commercial flight bound for Caticlan (Boracay).

The aircraft is the 1st delivery of 12 orders, and is the world's 1st dual class, 86-seat Q400 aircraft.






HOW TO GET THERE:


