




Happy New Year!



It was rediscovered in 1565 at the very spot where the Basilica Minore del Santo Nino, the oldest

church in the country now stands. The image miraculously sustained two fires which gutted the Ba-

Every year, millions go to Cebu specially during the Feast of the Santo Nino which is celebrated every third Sunday of January. Throngs of devotees visit the Basilica to venerate the Holy Child. This is preceded by a nine-day novena which culminates with the grand holy mass and the Sinulog Festival

Comes from the Cebuano word, "sulog which means current (water movement)

Sinulog Festival



"Sinulog" literally means "to move like flowing water." It is a religious and cultural festival held annually in Cebu every third Sunday of January in honor of the Santo Nino. When Ferdinand Magellan presented the image of the Holy Child as a gift to Queen Juana, the wife of Rajah Humabon, Chieftain of Cebu, she danced with joy holding the sacred image. Her dance steps were said to be the basis of the Sinulog dance which is widely

The festival's main event is the grand parade. Locals donned in colorful costumes dance the famous Sinulog dance (two steps forward, one step backward movement). There are pre-festival activities including

street parties, food fests, free concerts featuring local live bands and




