Mactan-Cebu International Airport receives the Airports Council International - Airport Health Accreditation (ACI-AHA)

Mactan-Cebu International Airport (MCIA) has received the Airport Health Accreditation from the Airports Council International (ACI) in recognition of the health and safety measures implemented in Terminals 1 & 2. These health and safety measures meet global airport standards such as the ACI Aviation Business Restart and Recovery guidelines, ICAO Council Aviation Restart Task Force (CART) recommendations, as well as other industry best practices. With this accreditation, CEB is recognized as one of the airports globally driving best industry practices for safe travel during the pandemic. The Airport Health Accreditation Certification was awarded to CEB on 26 January 2021.

We are committed to implementing and delivering best practices in the airport industry, particularly concerning the health and safety of our passengers, staff, and public," said Louie Ferrer, President of GMR MEGAWIDE Cebu Airport Corporation (GMCAC), private operator of MCIA.
